

# Guiding Children's Behaviour



Behaviour guidance is a process that focuses on the 'whole' child. Craigie Childcare Centre will provide a secure, loving and stimulating environment which encourages children to cooperate, enhances their self esteem and encourages their ability to interact with others.

We believe that the rights, interests, safety and learning journey of each individual child is main concern of our centre.

Positive guidance towards acceptable behaviour enables children to learn over time how to manage their feelings and take responsibility for their own actions.

We have modeled our approach to guiding child's behaviour and learning on the Early Years Learning Framework (2010).- Belonging, being and Becoming.
